WHY SHOULD KANSAS EXPAND OUR MEDICAID PROGRAM, KANCARE?



Health care costs are rising.

Expansion will help Kansans who currently have no options for coverage and keep costs down for the rest of us.



Current KanCare limits are too low.

A single parent with two dependent children must make less than about \$9,500 to qualify for KanCare.



Expansion will help address the general workforce shortage in Kansas.

When more people have access to health care, there are more workers healthy enough to re-enter or remain in the workforce.



Kansas is being left behind.

All of our surrounding states have expanded their Medicaid programs, leaving Kansas as one of only 12 states that haven't.



Kansans want a long-term solution.

Families should be able to count on affordable health coverage when they need it most.
