Supports a healthier workforce. Most in the coverage gap work at least one job, but aren't offered coverage through their employer. When people have access to the health care they need, there are more workers healthy enough to re-enter or remain in the workforce.



Makes Kansas more economically competitive. Expanding Medicaid helps our state compete with our neighbors who have already expanded their Medicaid programs.



Preserves & strengthens rural health care. Kansas has more rural hospitals at risk of closing than any other state our size. Expansion ensures rural Kansans can get the care they need while giving a boost to their economies.



Ensure uniform access to affordable health care for all Kansans. Expansion allows all Kansans to access affordable health care regardless of their race, how much money they make, or what their ZIP code is.
